BLASTING REQUIREMENTS

This notice shall accompany all blasting permits and the information contained herein shall be included as a part of any such permit.

1) No permit shall be issued without a valid request number from "Call Before You Dig" (BUD). This request number shall be obtained **at least 48 hours prior** to applying for said permit. "Call Before You Dig" may be reached at:

- 2) No permit shall be issued without a street address (number) or, in the absence thereof, a pole number or some other definitive locator.
- 3) Steel or rubber matting shall be used at <u>ALL</u> blast sites where required by the Bureau of Fire Prevention.
- 4) A pre-blast survey of the surrounding area may be required.
- 5) Seismographs are required for every blast. Their readings are to be supplied to the BFP on a pre-determined basis (every day, once a week).
- 6) Wires and debris must be cleared from all areas.
- 7) The Bureau of Fire Prevention, Hazardous Materials Division, must be notified between 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. for the day's blasting schedule. Please be as specific as possible. Prior approval by the Fire Marshal must be granted for blasting on weekends or Holidays.
- 8) Any additional conditions imposed shall also be adhered to which may include the Fire Marshal or his designee on site for all blasts.
